1. To install the program, insert the CD in the CD drive. The Auto install will bring up the program setup screen.
2. Follow the prompts to complete the installation.
3. After the installation is complete, you will see a shortcut icon on your computer desktop. Double click the shortcut icon to start the program.
4. If the CD does not autostart, click on the "START" button, then click "RUN", then click "BROWSE", then navigate to your CD drive where the Musicianship CD is located. Find the MusBaslInstaller.exe file and click on it, then click "OPEN", then click "OK".
